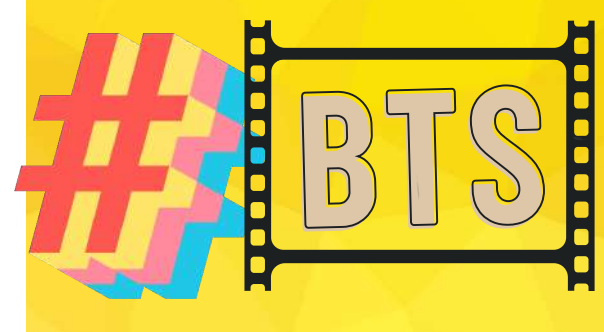
Happy Republic Day

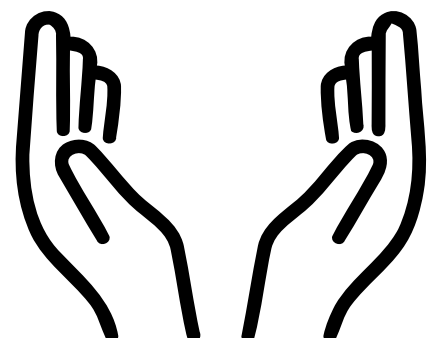
The Giving Hands

The French Connection

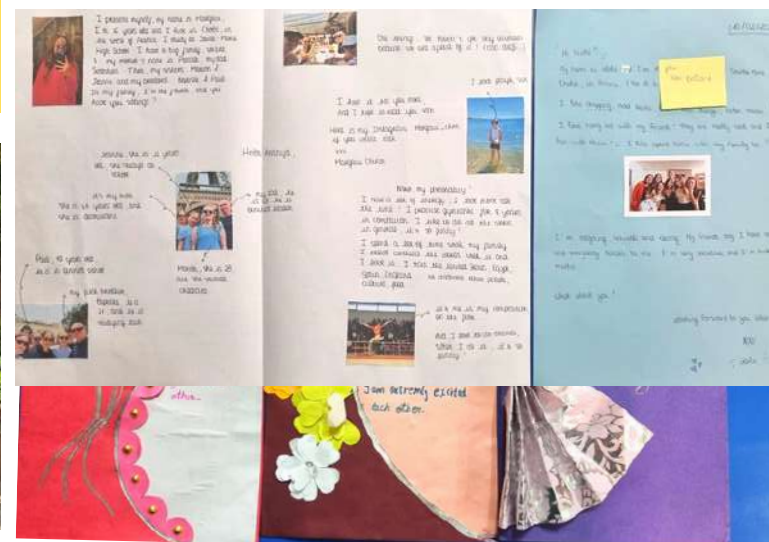

It was a great way to promote international peace and friendship and embrace new cultures.



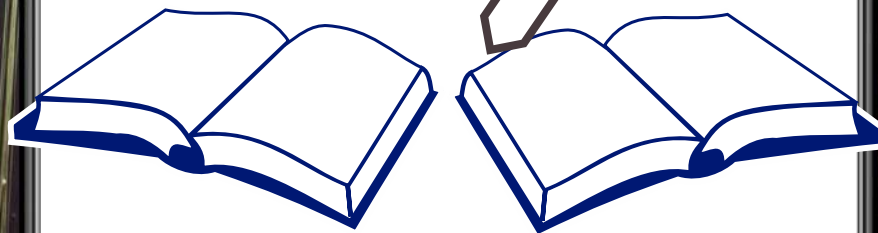
National Young Author's Fair
