PASSING CRITERIA FOR CLASS V-

- In order to be declared “Pass” at the end of the session for promotion to the next higher class, a student must secure at least 33% marks in each subject studied by him/her during the session. He/she must secure overall 33% marks i.e. 33 marks out of 100 [Marks of the attendance of the student (05 marks) plus marks of Subject Enrichment (05 marks) plus marks of Project Based Activities (05 Marks) plus marks of Portfolio (05 marks) plus marks of Multiple Assessment (05 marks) plus marks of Unit Test/Periodic Tests (05 marks) plus marks of Mid Term Exam (20 marks) and Annual Examination (50 marks) put together].
- The promotion to the next higher class is also subject to the condition that a minimum of 25% of marks must be scored in Mid Term Examination plus Annual Examination i.e. 18 marks out of 70 in each subject .

This is an exemplar card based on the National Curriculum Framework for School Education (NCF-SE-2023). It is assessed twice during the academic year, once in Term I and again in Term II, and is based on classroom participation, activities, projects, and daily learning experiences. The HPC helps in identifying each child's strengths and areas for improvement, enabling teachers and parents to work together to support the child's holistic development in a positive and nurturing environment.
